

THIRTY30 TENNIS INFORMATION SHEET

THIRTY30 Tennis is a shortened format of tennis

(Note: THIRTY30 Tennis can be abbreviated to T30 Tennis)

RULES & REGULATIONS

SCORING:

Scoring is identical to traditional tennis with every game starting at 30-all (30-30), announced "thirty-thirty".

TIE-BREAK:

If a set reaches 6 games each (i.e. 6-all), a 9 point tie-break (i.e. first to 5 points) is played to decide the winner of the set, i.e. by 7 games to 6.

FINAL SET:

There is no tie-break played in the final set. The final set must be won by leading by 2 clear games, i.e. 7-5, 8-6, for example.

CHANGE OF ENDS:

During a set, players shall serve alternate games and change ends after playing two, six and ten games.

i.e. change of ends occur after the first two games are played and then after every 4 games played.

Players shall also change ends at the end of each set.

SERVING:

Players alternate who serves first at the start of each set.

i.e. Player A serves first in sets one, three and five. Player B serves first in sets two and four.

MATCH FORMATS

One Thirty30 set. i.e. a T30 100 series match. (generally taking no longer than 20 minutes duration).

Best of three Thirty30 sets.

i.e. a T30 300 series match. (60 minutes duration).

Best of five Thirty30 sets. i.e. a T30 500 series match. (90 minutes duration).

A **Thirty30 final set** can be used as a an alternative to the Match (Champion's) Tie-Break (10 points)
