

Rules of Thirty30+ Tennis

To further shorten matches an additional alternative to the Thirty30 (T30) scoring method where every game starts from 30-30 is "Thirty30+" (T30+) ("thirty-thirty-plus") where the "No Ad" Rule IS USED, (i.e. a deciding 'sudden-death' point is played at Deuce), Service Receiver to decide 'deuce' or 'advantage' side.

The maximum number of Deuce points played during a Game is limited to either **ONE** or **TWO** or **THREE** when a 'sudden-death' point is played at Deuce.

Either:

'Golden' Deuce - A 'sudden-death' point is played after the FIRST Deuce

i.e. a maximum of **THREE** points are played per game.

Or:

<u>'Silver' Deuce</u> - A 'sudden-death" point is played after the **SECOND** Deuce <u>i.e.</u> a maximum of **FIVE** points are played per game.

Or:

<u>'Bronze' Deuce</u> - A 'sudden-death' point is played after the **THIRD** Deuce i.e. a maximum of **SEVEN** points are played per game.

The score of "**Deuce 1**" ('Golden' Deuce), "**Deuce 2**" ('Silver' Deuce) or "**Deuce 3**" ('Bronze' Deuce) is called out.
